ITINERARY

Tour Itinerary: Hyderabad - Dehradun - Barkot - Jankichatti - Yamunotri -

Uttarakashi -Gangotri - Guptkashi - Son Prayag - Kedarnath -Badrinath - Haridwar - Dehradun- Hyderabad

TOUR ITINERARY:

DAY: 1 - DEHRADUN – BARKOT / 125 KMS / 5-6 HRS:

Departure from Hyderabad at 10:25 Hrs. Arrival at Dehradun at 12:50 Hrs. Pickup from Dehradun airport drive to barkot. Evening arrival to Barkot check in at hotel. Dinner overnight stay at Barkot.

DAY : 2 - BARKOT – JANKI CHATTI – YAMUNOTRI – JANKICHATTI – BARKOT / 40 + 40 KMS DRIVE / 6 + 6 TREKKING / 9 - 10HRS:

Early morning drive to Janki Chatti to visit Yamunotri Temple (with Packed Breakfast). On arrival to Janki Chatti the base point of Yamunotri, booked Pony & Palki services from here (Own Cost). If you are fit enough you can do trekking also, quite a stiff trek. Arrival to Yamunotri visit the holy temple of Goddess Yamuna (3120m), present temple was built by Maharani of Jaipur Gularia Devi in 19th century. Natural hot water springs around the temple are main attraction for pilgrims. After the pooja / darshan return journey to Janki Chatti and drive back to Barkot for overnight stay.

DAY 3- BARKOT – UTTARKASHI / 100 KMS / 5-6 HRS:

After breakfast checkout from hotel and proceed to Uttarkashi, On arrival to Uttarkashi (1158m) visit Kashi -Vishwanath Temple. Later Checkin hotel dinner overnight stay in Uttarkashi.

DAY 4- UTTARKASHI – GANGOTRI –UTTARKASHI / 100 + 100 KMS / 11-12 HRS:

Early Morning 03:00 am proceed to visit Gangotri Temple (with Packed Breakfast). Along with Bhagirathi River the journey of Gangotri becomes a wonderful journey. Beautiful valleys, small rivers, waterfalls local villages, worth to visit over here. On arrival to Gangotri Temple (3050m) visit the holy temple of Goddess Ganga, pooja / darshan. The present temple of Gangotri was built in 18th century by Gurkha commander Amar Singh Thapa. After the visit over return journey to Uttarkashi for overnight stay.

DAY 5- UTTARKASHI – GUPTKASHI 250 – 290 / KMS / 10-11 HRS:

Today after early morning breakfast check out from hotel and proceed to Guptkashi. Evening arrival to Guptkashi transfer to hotel, after dinner overnight stay.

DAY 6- GUPTKASHI – KEDARNATH / DRIVING 35 / TREKKING 16 / 8 -9 HRS:

Early morning 2:00 am checkout from hotel and proceed to Sonprayag Shuttle Parking take local shuttle Taxi services (own cost) to reach Gaurikund, the base point of Kedarnath. Book your Pony & Palki services from here (own cost) for Kedarnath journey. Trekking route begin from Gaurikund, On arrival to Kedarnath check in to dharamshala, after freshen up visit Kedarnath temple for evening Aarti Darshan. Overnight stay at Kedarnath.

DAY 7- KEDARNATH – GAURIKUND - GUPTKASHI ONE SIDE TREK 16 KMS / DRIVING 35 KMS /6-7 HRS:

Early morning today 5: am visit the Kedarnath temple for Pooja/Darshan/ Abhishek. Amongst the 12th Jyotirlinga of Lord Shiva 11th is situated in Kedarnath. The ancient temple of Kedarnath was built by Pandavas and renovated by Jagat Guru Shankaracharya in 7th century. After breakfast checkout from hotel and trek down to Gaurikund 16km trek. Overnight stay at Guptkashi.

DAY 8- GUPTKASHI - BADRINATH / 220 – 250 KMS / 9-10 HRS:

Today after early morning breakfast proceed to Badrinath, en route visit Narsingh Swami Temple at Josimath. At night arrival to Badrinath (3400m), transfer to hotel dinner and night Stay.

DAY 9- BADRINATH –BIRAH/ RUDRAPRAYAG/ SRINAGAR (140-200 KMS) / 5-8 HRS:

Early morning 03:00 am visit Badrinath Temple for Abhishek/ Alankar darshan. The present holy temple of Badrinath was built by Adi Guru Shankaracharya during 7th century. The main idol of Lord Vishnu is built of black stone known as "Salegram". Before the visit of Badrinath temple one must take a holy dip inside "Taptkunda" a natural hot water spring situated outside the temple. After the darshan of temple also perform the pooja/tarpan outside the temple near Brahmkapal. After breakfast checkout from hotel drive to Mana the first village of India situated on Indo - Tibet-Border visit Ganesh Gufa, Beas Gufa, Bhimpool and Saraswati river. Later on proceed to Rudraprayag, hotel checkin dinner and for overnight Stay.

DAY 10- BIRAH/RUDRAPRAYAG/SRINAGAR – HARIDWAR / (200-120 KMS) / 8-5 HRS:

Today morning after breakfast checkout the hotel and proceed to Haridwar enroute visit Dhari Devi Temple. On arrival free time for exploration of Har ki Pauri and local temple. Evening enjoy Ganga Aarti. Hotel Checking dinner and overnight stay at Haridwar.

DAY 11- HARIDWAR – DEHRADUN:

Early Morning free for Ganga Snan and visit of Mansa Devi Temple Darshan. Back to hotel for breakfast checkout from hotel by 12:00 Hrs and drive to Dehradun. Departure from Dehradun at 19:25 hrs. Arrival at Hyderabad Airport at 21:55 Hrs. Journey concludes with everlasting memories of Chardham.

Note: Pony – Palki Charges, Helicopter Tickets, Ropeway are not included in tour price. It has to be directly borne by the tourist. IRCTC will have no role in this.

SIGNIFICANCE OF PLACES

YAMUNOTRI

Yamunotri Temple is situated in the western region of Garhwal Himalayas at an altitude of 3293 metres. The temple is dedicated to the river Yamuna. The tiny Yamuna has icy cold water and its absolute innocence and the infantile purity heightens that deep feeling of reverence, which Yamunotri has for the devout. The trek to Yamunotri is truly spectacular, dominated by a panorama of rugged peaks and dense forests.

Close to the temple are hot water springs gushing out from the mountain cavities. Suryakund is the most important Kund. Near the Suryakund there is a shila called Divya Shila, which is worshipped before puja is offered to the deity.

GANGOTRI

The temple is nested amidst the beautiful surroundings of deodars and pine trees. It lies close to the holy rock or the Bhagirath Shila where King Bhagirath had worshiped Lord Shiva. The Gangotri temple is dedicated to Goddess Ganga.

BADRINATH

The main entrance gate of Badrinath temple is colourful and imposing popularly known as Singhdwar. The temple is approximately 50 feet tall with a small cupola on top, covered with a gold gilt roof.

KEDARNATH

The Temple at Kedarnath dedicated to Lord Shiva, the Kedarnath temple has exquisite architecture Built of extremely large, heavy and evenly cut grey slabs of stones, it evokes wonder as to how these heavy slabs were moved and handled in the earlier centuries. The temple has a Garbha Griha for worship and a Mandap, apt for assemblies of pilgrims and visitors.

Terms and Conditions:

General Guidelines to the Passengers:

1. All prices mentioned are 'Per Person'.
2. The package Price is subject to change without prior notice.
3. The mentioned package price is as on date of booking. However, in case of increase in input costs such as GST, hotel room rates levy by the hotel especially during peak season / holiday surcharge and major events/ fairs and convention or any other expenses beyond the control of IRCTC, the guests are liable to pay the additional amount before commencement of journey.
4. In case any of the sightseeing spot mentioned in the itinerary remains closed due to local reason, IRCTC will arrange for alternative sightseeing spot. All guests are requested to cooperate in this regard.
5. Alternate Arrangements will be made disruption of tour on account of natural calamities and the cost to be borne by the tourist.
6. IRCTC has right to alter itinerary under unavoidable circumstances and is not liable for any type of natural calamities/ strikes/ cancellations/ delay of flight/insurgency of any such nature which is beyond control during the tour period.
7. Covering all sightseeing places are subject to time availability, weather & road conditions. All sightseeing places are subject to opening of tourist destinations and time availability.
8. The decision of IRCTC/SCZ will be final on account of problems arising in the conduct of the tour.
9. The guests are requested to take care of their personal belongings carefully and avoid leaving them unattended.
10. Management is not accountable for any theft or damage of luggage during the trip.
11. Arrangements will be made for medical attention during sickness while on tour and the cost will borne by the tourist.
12. Passengers above age of 75 are required to accompany by an escort/family member of younger age.
13. Package operation is subject to government guidelines at the destinations.
14. Allotted time slots by any facility/tourist attraction/activity should be followed by all tourists for the convenience of service providers and other tourists.
15. IRCTC will not be responsible if the tourists do not abide by the safety guidelines and get penalized by concern authorities for violating the same.
16. Passenger should call any queries about the tour from IRCTC before/after the booking to avoid any confusion.
17. CHARDHAM YATRA is seasonal. Thus at times during the course of operations of the tour the carrying capacity of the destination gets affected.
18. Please carry your regular medicines, doctor's prescriptions & contact number, torch, lock & chain for securing luggage, Woolen cloths.

Hotels:

1. Final confirmation in the proposed hotels is subject to the availability at the time of booking, else similar category hotel will be provided.
2. Room categories in all packages are the base category rooms unless stated otherwise.
3. Final confirmation in the proposed hotels is subject to the availability at the time of booking, else similar category hotel will be provided. (Dormitory accommodation will be provided in Dharamshala at Kedarnath)
4. The request for an adjacent or an adjoining room will be on subject to availability only and will incur extra charges if adjoining room is of higher category.
5. Room allocation (Twin bed / Double bed) is at the discretion of the hotel. The check in and check out time of the hotel is fixed as per Hotel Guidelines. Numbers of meals are always corresponding to the number of nights booked. Breakfast is not provided on the day of arrival.
6. In hotels for an extra Adult / Child either Rollaway bed or mattress shall be provided.
7. Three person of one family on one booking will be accommodated in one double room with an extra Mattress.
8. Child will be accommodated in one room with the parents only.
9. Payments pertaining to early check- in, late check-out, items consumed in Room Minibar and any extra services of hotel other than mentioned in the package are to be settled at hotel directly by the guest.
10. Hotel has the right to claim the damages incurred by any of the guest.

Transfers and Sightseeing:

1. Transfers and Sightseeing tours are on sharing basis.
2. Arrival / departure transfers & sightseeing tours shall be provided as per schedule fixed by the IRCTC. However this may require you to wait at the airport/destination for short duration until arrival of all the guests.
3. Vehicle is not on personal disposal basis. Vehicle will be provided as per the schedule of the itinerary.
4. Tour Vehicle will be allotted based on number of adults booked for the tour.
5. Category of the vehicle will be decided as per the group size.

Force Majeure

'Force majeure' means any event which we / the supplier of the service(s) in question / the Third Party Supplier could not, even with all due care, foresee or avoid. Such events may include disruptions/diversions of rail services, floods, earthquakes, whether actual or threatened war, riot, civil strife, actual or threatened terrorist activity, industrial dispute, natural or nuclear disaster, adverse weather conditions, disease, fire and all similar events outside the control of the party concerned.

We cannot accept liability or pay any compensation where the performance or prompt performance of our obligations under our agreement with you is prevented or affected by, or you otherwise suffer any damage or loss as a result of, 'force

majeure'.

IRCTC will not be responsible for any injury, illness, death, loss, damage, expense, cost or other claim of any description whatsoever which results from:

- The act(s) and / or omission(s) of the person(s) affected or any member(s) of their party
- The act(s) and / or omission(s) of a third party not connected with the provision of your arrangements and which were unforeseeable or unavoidable; or Any service or facility not arranged by us as part of our contract with you; or 'force majeure' as defined above.
