Day	Destination	Particulars
01	Mumbai – Guwahati	Upon arrival at Guwahati Airport, transfer to the hotel. . In the evening, enjoy a memorable dinner on a river cruise over the Brahmaputra River. <i>Cruise operation is subject to weather conditions and availability.</i> Overnight stay in Guwahati (D).
02	Guwahati	After breakfast, visit to Kamakhya Temple for Mukh Darshan - The temple is dedicated to goddess Kamakhya, an incarnation of Sati. <i>(Guests who are willing to go for Special Darshan of Kamakhya Temple may book online tickets on their own. Transfer charges to be borne by the guest).</i> Navagraha Temple, Umananda Temple and Srimanta Sankardev Kalakshetra. Overnight stay in Guwahati. (B, D).
03	Guwahati – Shillong	After breakfast, check out from the hotel and drive to Shillong. En route, visit the picturesque Umiam Lake. Shillong, the capital of Meghalaya, is nestled amidst pine-covered hills and is popularly known as the “Scotland of the East.” On arrival, check in to the hotel and relax. Overnight stay in Shillong (B, D).
04	Shillong – Dawki & Mawlynnong	After breakfast, proceed for a full-day excursion to Dawki and Mawlynnong. Visit the Indo-Bangladesh Border and the scenic Umngot River at Dawki. Guests may enjoy a country boat ride on a direct payment basis, subject to availability. Later, proceed to Mawlynnong Village, known for its cleanliness and natural beauty. Explore the village and visit the nearby Riwai Living Root Bridge and the unique Balancing Rock. Return to Shillong in the evening. Overnight stay in Shillong (B,D).
05	Shillong – Cherrapunji	After breakfast, proceed for an excursion to Cherrapunji (Sohra), renowned for its spectacular waterfalls, caves and lush green landscapes. Visit Nohkalikai Falls, Mawmai Cave, Seven Sister Falls, Garden of Caves and Eco Park. While returning to Shillong, visit the famous Elephant Falls. Overnight stay in Shillong. (B, D).
06	Shillong – Kaziranga National Park	After breakfast, check out from the hotel and drive to Kaziranga National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of India’s most renowned wildlife destinations. Kaziranga is famous for the Great Indian One-Horned Rhinoceros and is also home to elephants, wild water buffalo, swamp deer and several other species of wildlife. On arrival, check in to the hotel and relax. Overnight stay in Kaziranga (B, D).
07	Kaziranga – Jorhat	Early morning, proceed for an Elephant Safari in Kaziranga National Park, subject to availability and applicable forest department regulations. Return to the hotel for breakfast, followed by a Jeep Safari in the national park. Later, check out and visit Kaziranga Orchid Park before proceeding to Jorhat. On arrival, check in to the hotel. Evening is at leisure. Overnight stay in Jorhat. (B, D).

08	Jorhat – Majuli Island	After an early breakfast, proceed for a day excursion to Majuli Island, one of the world's largest inhabited river islands and an important centre of Assamese culture and Vaishnavite traditions. Enjoy a ferry ride to Majuli and explore its rich cultural heritage. Visit Sri Sri Samaguri Satra, renowned for its traditional mask-making art. Later, explore the local market and surroundings and shop for regional handicrafts and souvenirs. Return to Jorhat in the evening. Overnight stay in Jorhat. (B, D).
09	Jorhat – Mumbai	After breakfast, check out from the hotel and proceed to Jorhat Airport for your onward flight to your home destination. Tour concludes with wonderful memories of Assam and Meghalaya..(D).
