Package Title: - Kateel - Dharmasthala - Kukke Vistadome Package (2Nights/3Days)

Vistadome is a state-of-the-art coach designed by railways to provide guests with travel comfort and enhanced viewing of the natural surroundings. A journey with a seat in the Vistadome coach traversing through Western Ghats offers several frames of greenery and natural beauty. The scenic Sakleshpur - Subrahmanya Ghat section is the highlight of the journey, offering breathtaking glimpses of mountains. The journey on the vistadome coach will allow everyone to stay up close with nature and explore natural wonders in their full glory.

Someshwara Beach is a rocky beach on the outskirts of Mangaluru city in coastal Karnataka. River Netravati confluences with Arabian Sea near the Beach. The Beach gets its name from Someshwara temple nearby. Sunset view from the beach is very popular.

Kateel Durga Parameshwari Temple, located on an island in Nandini river. The temple dedicated to Goddess Durga Parameshwari is in the form of an Udhbhava Moorthi (naturally formed). The pillars of the temple also have beautiful sculptures. It is considered one of the holiest Hindu temple towns in India.

Dharmasthala is Located amid the sylvan surroundings on the Western Ghats. This well-known pilgrimage center on the banks of Netravati river, in Belthangady taluk of Dakshin Kannada district, is an interesting amalgam of faiths. It is arguably the most visited religious place in Karnataka. Dharmasthala is a remarkable example of communal, religious and cultural harmony.

Kukke- Nestled between hills, this pilgrim center is famous for the 5000 years old Kukke **Subramanya Temple** on the banks of Kumaradhara river. The epics narrate how the divine serpent Vasuki and other snakes took refuge under Lord Subrahmanya, in the caves. Here Lord Subrahmanya is worshipped as a snake and pooja is offered to Him, who is merged with serpent king Vasuki. Hence, believed to be the ultimate solace for salvation from any sort of Naga Doshas.

ITINERARY

Tour Itinerary: Yeshwanthpur -Mangalore - Dharmasthala- Kukke- Bengaluru (2N/3D)

DAY 01 (Saturday): Board the Vistadome Coach on Train No. 16539 at 07:00 Hrs from Yeshwanthpur railway station. Enjoy natures beauty through the Vistadome till late afternoon. Deboard at Bantawala station by 1540 Hrs. Meet the designated cab driver and transfer to Someshwar Beach. Evening at leisure. Later check in hotel for overnight stay.





DAY 02 (Sunday): Check out from hotel and transfer to Kateel Devi Temple. Later depart to Dharmasthala visit Sri Manjunath Temple and proceed to Kukke. Visit Sri Kukke Subramanya Temple. Night drop to Subrahmanya Road railway station by 19.30 hrs. Depart to Bangalore by Train No. 16586 at 20:40Hrs. Overnight Journey.

DAY 03 (Monday): Arrive Bangalore at 06:15Hrs

COVID-19 GUIDELINES:

Generic preventive measures:

The generic measures include simple public health measures that are to be followed to reduce the risk of COVID-19. These measures need to be observed by all supporting staff and tourists during tour package services at all times.

- 1. Physical distancing of at least 6 feet to be followed as far as feasible.
- 2. Use of face covers/masks to be made mandatory.
- 3. Practice frequent hand washing with soap (for at least 40-60 seconds) even when hands are not visibly dirty. Use of alcohol-based hand sanitizers (for at least 20 seconds) can be made wherever feasible like train/transport/stay etc.
- 4. Respiratory etiquettes to be strictly followed. This involves strict practice of covering one's mouth and nose while coughing/sneezing with a Tissue/handkerchief/flexed elbow and disposing off used tissues properly.
- 5. Self-Monitoring of health by all and reporting any illness at the earliest to Tour manager and IRCTC helpline.
- 6. Installation & use of Aarogya Setu App, Shall be advised to all (Supporting staff& Tourists).
- 1. Avoid touching the eyes, nose and mouth with the hands.
- 2. Abide to the mandatory health advisories issued by the States/Local administration which are being visited.
- 3. Avoid physical contact while greeting each other.
- 4. Avoid travel if symptomatic.
- 5. Stay away from elderly and people with morbidity. Persons above 65 years of age, persons with morbidities, pregnant women and children below the age of 10 years are advised to take extra precautions as per Govt. guidelines.
- 6. Heart & blood pressure patients, pregnant women, persons suffering from medical problems, senior citizens etc need to be cautious while traveling and should be accompanied by someone.
- 1. Avoid using other tourists' phone, Water bottle, Umbrella etc as much as possible.
- 2. All tourists are advised that spitting is strictly prohibited in train, tourist places, buses, hotels/Dharmashala etc.
- 3. Following of social distancing during boarding/de-boarding of train/ any other transport, Monuments & pilgrim places visit, lunches/dinners etc.
- 1. Avoid loitering and crowding in train corridors, gates, cabins, buses, hotels/Dharmashala etc.
- 2. Avoid visiting public places / congregations other than the planned purpose of visit and avoid public transport.
- 3. Encourage online purchase of entry tickets to National Parks/Wildlife sanctuaries, monuments etc.
- 4. Do not Touch statues/idols/holy books etc, inside the religious places.





- 5. No physical offerings like Prasad/distribution or sprinkling of holy water etc. inside the religious place.
- 6. Tourists should avoid handling cash as much as possible. Payments may be done through digital modes to the extent possible.

Important: -

- i. Covering all sightseeing places are subject to time availability, weather & road conditions. All sightseeing places are subject to opening of tourist destinations and time availability.
- ii. Package operation is subject to government guidelines at the destinations.
- iii. The itinerary of the package is indicative only and handling agency reserves the right to change itinerary during operation of the tour due to local circumstances.
- iv. Opening of Wild Life Sanctuaries/ National Parks are subject to the discretion of the Forest Dept.
- v. Allotted time slots by any facility/tourist attraction/activity should be followed by all tourists for the convenience of service providers and other tourists.
